THE FIRST RESIDENTS OF THE CO-HATY NEAR KAMIANETS-PODILSKYI

People evacuated from the frontline areas became the first residents of the former dormitory in Zinkivtsi, near Kamianets-Podilskyi. Our partners shared the information about CO-HATY housing with them.

Zinkivtsi has already become home to 26 IDPs, including a family with six children and elderly people, for whom the decision to evacuate was extremely difficult.

We are very grateful to the special police unit White Angel, our partners Base UA, and the organization Ne Sami, who are directly involved in the evacuation. We appreciate the opportunity to become a link of support for people fleeing the russian threat.

This spring, we selected future buildings for renovation and arrangement. In May, our team was preparing documentation to start work at the new sites. More details coming soon.

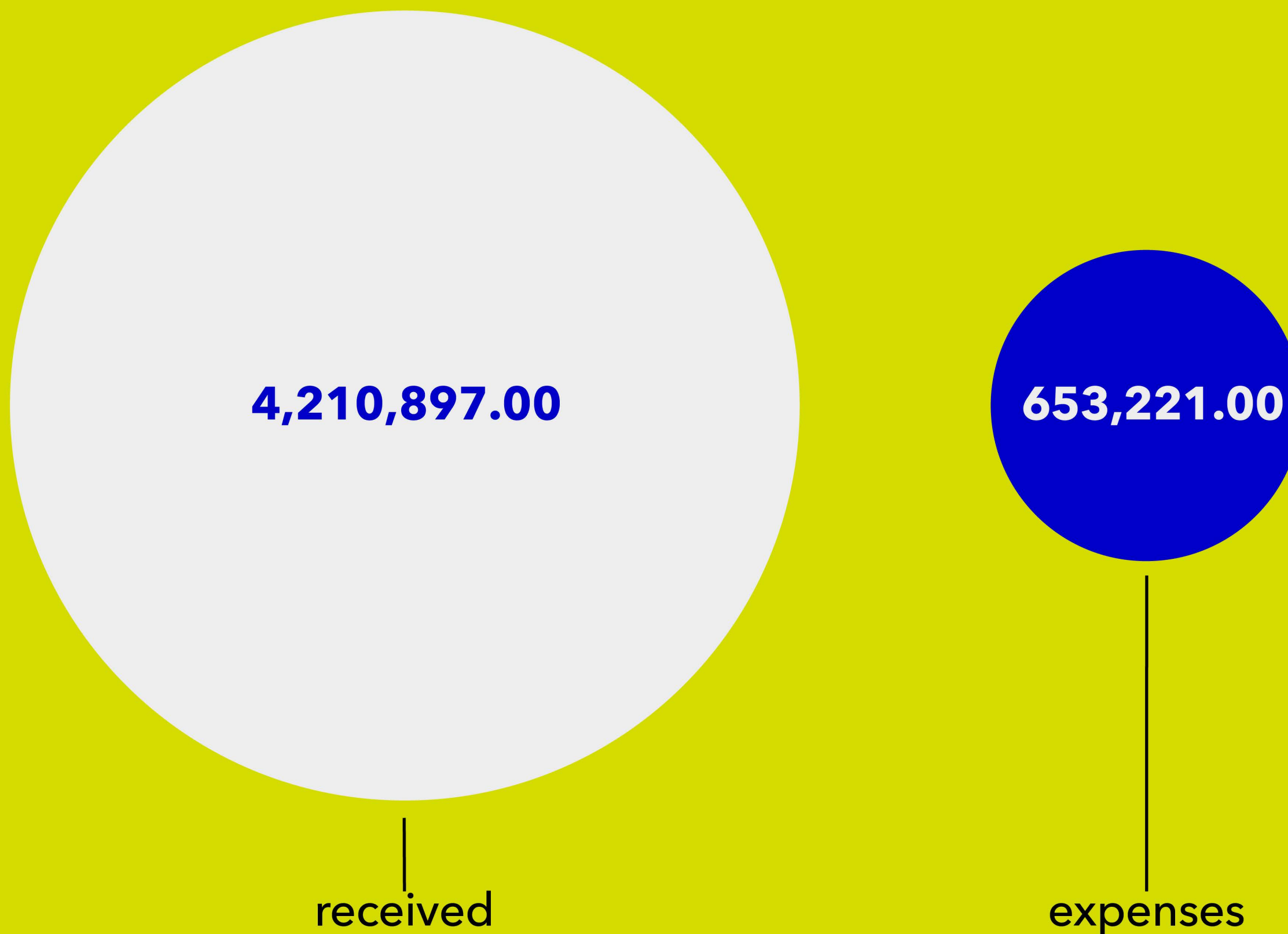


SUPPORT FROM THE ORGANIZATION #LEAVENOONEBEHIND

FUNDS

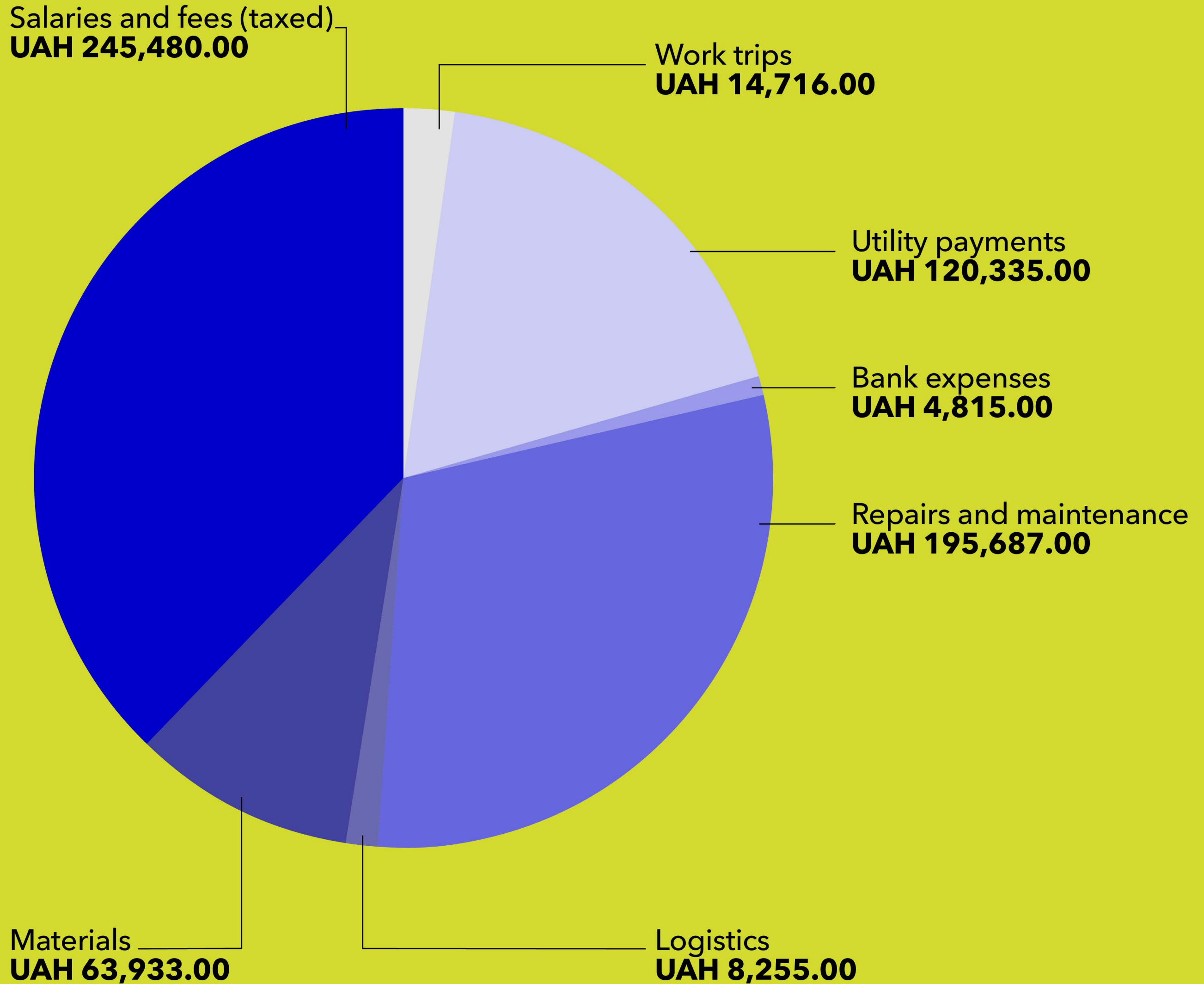


In May, CO-HATY project received **UAH 4,210,897.00**.
